Mussel Inspector Update

No boats are allowed to use the RDR ramp without a current mussel inspection certificate. **If you have not paid your annual dues for 2020, you will not be eligible for a mussel inspection.** Pyramid, Hughes and Castaic Lakes are now infested with mussels. Any boat on those waters in the last 30 days will be turned away. Mussel inspectors and their phone numbers will be posted on the white board at the Point.
