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ROAD MAINTENENCE/POINT: Don Bullard

We have completed the Aluffo Rd. project. The initial 3 year time to completion was accomplished in 2 years resulting in a substantial overall savings.

At this time we are back to minimum road repairs when problems arise.

It is important to know that the next road improvement needed is in 3 to 5 years. We need to start now preparing for a complete road resurfacing at this time. This means the addition of a layer of asphalt as well as shoulder repairs. The cost of this will be significantly more than the slurry coating of the road that has just taken place.

Regarding the point, Jerry Reese is looking into the possibility of adding concrete blocks to the uphill side of the launch ramp. This may be able to be achieved with minimal cost to the membership.

DOCKS: Jerry Ford:

Reviewed the current dock ownership and placement on the point. Had some questions about who owned what dock which was answered by members of the board. He had also done some research on the county requirements for dock mooring. But received little help from the county.

FIRE: Jerry Reese

Talked a little about the recent fires that had happened and reinforced the need for proper fire clearance as well as the new updated fire tree.
