SNRA BOARD MEETING
November 12, 2017

Call to order:

The meeting was called to order by Pres. John Hunter at 9:07AM.

Roll Call:

John Hunter (Pres.), Chuck Enterline (Sec.), Sue Kennedy (Treas.), Bill Gough (Cal-Shasta), Russ Johnson (Private Owners), Leo Kennedy, Carl Steinkraus (Run Deer), Faron Goodwin, Randy Tognazzini (Tri-Counties).

Absent: Jim Shockey (Private Owners), Ken Thomas (VP), John Runels (Cal-Shasta), Brent McClurg (South Shore).

In the Audience:

Josh Taylor, Jim Gray and other members of Cal Fire, Georgia Steinkraus, Susie Johnson and John Andreasen.

Election of Officers:

After a call for nominations, no new candidates were named.

MOTION: Leo Kennedy moved to re-elect all of the current officers to another two-year term, 2nd by Randy Tognazzini. Motion passed unanimously.

Russ Johnson announced that Jim Shockey is stepping down as a Rep. for Private Owners, to be replaced by Bill Barton.

Minutes of Previous Meeting:

(10/08/2017) reviewed by e-mail, were presented for approval.

MOTION: Randy Tognazzini moved to accept the Minutes, Russ Johnson 2nd it. Motion passed unanimously.

Treasures Report:

Sept. began with \$45,155.74. Income was \$0.00, expenses of \$710.22 leaving a balance of \$44,445.52. October income was 230.95, expenses of \$402.16, leaving a balance of \$44,274.31.

There were no invoices to be paid.

MOTION: Carl Steinkraus moved to accept the Treasurer's Report, Faron Goodwin 2nd it. Motion passed unanimously.

Correspondence:

A letter was received from the Dept. of Fish and Wildlife acknowledging receipt of our Notification of Lake or Streambed Alteration for the Sandy Creek Sediment Removal project. Basically it outlined the time table for DFW's review of our request. By Dec. 12th, either we will receive permission to proceed or there will be no need for any agreement and we may proceed.

Mary Bishop wrote a letter thanking Russ Johnson for all the work that he and SNRA do.

Committee Reports:

Electric Gate: Carl said that he and Jerry Ahrens performed a general cleaning and maintenance on the gate opener and motor. All is in working. They are still trying to get a monitor for the security camera set-up.

Carl also reported continued problems at the Gage Irving emergency gate. It has been vandalized multiple times. Locks cut off or locks put on to lock the gate open. If you see anyone doing anything with that gate, please ask them what they are doing and why.

MOTION: Leo Kennedy moved to spend up to \$500 for a small sign directing people to the main (RDR) gate to be placed on the Gage Irving gate and to purchase a security camera to monitor activity. Randy Tognazzini seconded it. Motion passed unanimously.

Membership: No new members.

Budget and Maintenance: John Hunter brought up the previously discussed removal of dead/burned trees within the SNRA easement. Russ Johnson replied with information on the Fire Safe Council and the Fire Focus Group of Lake Nacimiento. Russ wrote a proposal to obtain a \$70,000 grant from the state to deal with tree clearing along the sides of the SNRA roads and some “second tier” roads in the area. \$30,000 is in place for the work with the additional \$40,000 pending approval. Bunyon Brothers will be doing the work. Russ has submitted proposals for additional projects. He indicated that Monterey Co has approved this work on their property.

Fire Committee: Randy Tognazzini proposed petitioning Supervisor Peschong to get the county to keep Cal Fire Station 35 (Las Tablas) open year round. Josh Taylor, the Cal Fire Battalion Chief, said that keeping Station 35 open year round depended on input from the community balanced against county-wide need. He didn't say not to try, but that there are places in the county with much denser population and under staffed fire support. He indicated this station is scheduled to remain open through Dec. 1, 2017 and reopen May 1, 2018.

Josh confirmed that the recent fires in Tri-Counties were electrical in nature.
