**SNRA BOARD MEETING**  
**January 20, 2019**

Call to order: The meeting was called to order by Pres. John Hunter at 9:02 AM at the Cal-Shasta Clubhouse.

Roll Call: John Hunter (Pres.), Ken Thomas (VP), Chuck Enterline (Sec.), Sue Kennedy (Treas.), Cindy McGee & Ken Thomas (Cal-Shasta), Russ Johnson & Bill Barton (private owners), Leo Kennedy & Carl Steinkraus (Running Deer), Brent McClurg (South Shore), Randy Tognazzini & Faron Goodwin (Tri-Counties).

Visitors: Ken McAlister, James Hunter & Susie Johnson.

President's Message: Best to all throughout the upcoming year. Thank you for your service on the SNRA board.

Minutes of Previous Meeting: (Oct 14, 2018) were presented for approval as printed in the SNRA Newsletter.

**MOTION: Randy Tognazzini made the motion to accept the Minutes as printed, Bill Barton seconded it. The motion passed unanimously.**

Treasurers Report: Oct. began with \$76,146.53, income: \$160.00, expenses: \$63,603.18 leaving a balance of \$12,703.35. Nov. income: \$0, expenses: \$151.25 an ending balance of \$12,552.10. Dec. income: \$120.86, expenses: \$472.71, leaving a balance of \$12,200.25.

**MOTION: Leo Kennedy made a motion to accept the Treasurers Report, Russ Johnson seconded it. The motion passed unanimously.**

Sue Kennedy asked for approval to integrate the Fire Fund and Town Creek Study Fund into the general savings account.

**MOTION: Randy Tognazzini made a motion to move the Fire Fund and Town Creek Fund, Leo Kennedy seconded it. The motion passed, 8 for and 1 against.**

Correspondence: Randy Tognazzini emailed John Hunter asking about the Fee Discount for Unimproved Properties program. It was pointed out that the discount is allowed only if there is "no water, no power, no structure and no vehicle storage on it for the whole year". Owners must apply for the discount, in writing every year. Randy said that answered his question.

Committee Reports:

Electric Gate: The Jan. & Feb. codes were given out. Carl Steinkraus reported that the main gate was open for several days. CalFire had mistakenly left it open, when notified they closed it. Carl said he is training a couple of people in the gate maintenance.

Ken McAlister, of Running Deer was introduced. He has offered to take on the maintenance of the security camera at the front gate. He had previously been asked to research cameras to replace the current, very outdated ones. He gave a thorough report of his findings.

**MOTION: Leo Kennedy made a motion to have Ken purchase and install a new camera with a budget up to \$1,200, Carl Steinkraus seconded it. The motion passed unanimously.**

Membership: New members, Tom Bernardy and Nancy Timmons, bought Shelby See's property in Running Deer. In Tri-Counties, Andrew Grow took over the membership of Bob Gioia.

Budget and Maintenance: Leo handed out a summary of SNRA Road Work from 2008 to 2018. He said that the last storm caused enough damage with clogged culverts and mud slides to bring in Frederick's Paving to do some of the cleanup. They will be clearing the mud and creating a safety berm on Cal-Shasta Hill where the road is being eroded on the downhill side by mudslides. After the rainy season ends, plans for the annual road maintenance will be made.

Fire Committee: Russ Johnson gave an update on the Fire Focus Group. Grants have been approved with \$775,000 allotted for projects around the lake. Work is to start March 1st. Grant requests for 2019 have been filed.

Jerry Reese is in charge of the Fire Wise Community. An event, (Brunch? BBQ?) to bring the community together for information and sharing fire safety planning will be held May 4, 2019. **SAVE THE DATE** and plan to come to the Cal-Shasta Clubhouse.
