SNRA ANNUAL MEETING

Oct. 10, 2021

Call to order: The meeting was called to order by John Hunter at 9:07 AM.

Roll Call: John Hunter (Pres.), Ken Thomas (VP), Chuck Enterline (Sec.), Sue Kennedy (Treas.), Ken Thomas & Lee Davis (Cal-Shasta), Russ Johnson & Jeff Amos (private owners), Leo Kennedy & John Crass (Running Deer), Randy Tognazzini & Faron Goodwin (Tri-Counties) and Brent McClurg (SSVC).

Visitors: Mike Lemos (Tri-Counties) and Bart Matta (Private Owner)

President's Message: Thank you to Leo Kennedy for heading up all the road work and to all Board members for their support this year. This year's road work is complete. The vote on the 2021-2022 Budget will take place at this meeting. Thank you to the ballot counters.

Minutes of Previous Meeting: (Aug 8, 2021) were presented for any changes.

Motion: Ken Thomas made the motion to accept the Minutes; Russ Johnson seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

Treasurers Report: Invoices presented for payment: To Michael Frederick Paving Corp. for \$149,142.00. *Motion:* Randy Tognazzini made the motion to approve payment; Brent McClurg seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

The balance forward into August was \$181,685.47. Income: \$1,800.16, expenses: \$2,011.84; closing out the fiscal year with \$181,473.79. September; income: \$0.34, expenses \$232.20, balance forward \$181,241.93. *Motion:* Faron Goodwin made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report; Leo Kennedy seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

Correspondence: John Hunter received a call from John Hogan regarding the road closure for road maintenance work. John Hunter suggested we give a longer notice time with future road projects. How to handle long road delays/closures going forward will be discussed later.

Committee Reports:

- --Electric Gate: Codes were given. The gate has been working well. To be put on the list for monthly guest/contractor gate code notification, contact Leo Kennedy at kennedyments.com.
- --Membership: Sue reported there have been many new members this year too many to list. She also requested new member updates from each of the clubs.
- --Budget and Maintenance: Leo gave a review of the road work completed this year. Several members commented on how good the roads are. The only work left for this year is the instillation of a cattle guard by Monterey County. A drive- by lane will by provided.

Looking toward the work for 2022, which is always dependent on what happens with winter rains, widening and shoring up the hillside along the "one lane ahead" area of Cal Shasta hill is a priority.

The budget vote was counted by: Susie Johnson (Private Owners), Karen Crass (Running Deer), Donna Foutch (S. Shore), Debi Lemos and Eric Gamble (Tri-Counties). Thank you all!

The Proposed Budget for 2021-22 was approved by a vote of: 117 YES, 5 NO. Thank you to those of you who took the time to vote.

--Fire & Emergency Response Committee Reports: Russ Johnson reported on grants for fire suppression. \$4.7 million has been allotted to SLO County with \$100,000 of that directed to the south side of Lake Nacimiento. Much of

the work will be a continuation of the tree and brush clearing and chipping that has been going for a few years. Clearing around the clubs and in parts of Running Deer are in the plans. Russ said work may start in November.

Lee Davis presented current status and use of the Text Message Emergency Alert system. There are currently about 200 people signed on to the text alert system. Mark Garza and Russ Johnson, as well as Lee have been authorized to initiate texts. Lee is looking for someone from South Shore, who lives at the lake, to be a contact.

--Website editor: Nick Koonce, who has overseen the website for many years, won't be doing it any more. He has worked with Cindy McGee on access and maintenance. Nick will helping us look for another server company & he will help with transitioning.
