# SNRA GENERAL MEETING

Oct 12, 2014 – Cal-Shasta Clubhouse

Call to Order by Pres. Phil Humfrey @ 9:00AM.

Roll Call: All representatives present with Mike Lemos substituting for Randy Tognazzini, Tri Counties rep.

President's Opening Remarks: The purpose of this meeting is to approve/disapprove the budget for 2014-2015. The ballots will be counted during the meeting. Thanks for all attending. Special thanks to all Board members and volunteers for their work with SNRA business and to all who submitted a ballot.

General Meeting Minutes from Oct. 13, 2013 were approved with no "Nays". Russ Johnson made the **motion**, Brent McClurg made the second.

Treasure's Report: Sue Kennedy reported for the month of August, which finished out the fiscal year, there was income of \$250.00, expenses of \$128,193.73, leaving an ending balance of \$24,766.48. For September, an income of \$1,055.61, expenses of \$181.65, leaving an ending balance of \$25,640.44. Jim Shockey made a **motion** to approve, Mike Lemos seconded it and the motion passed with no "Nays".

Correspondence: Sue indicated no incoming mail/email. She sent two thank you letters, one to Tim & Debbie Kopack and Yesterdays Sportswear for the donated t-shirts and caps, one to Jane Calder of Arroyo Grande for her review of the SNRA books. Phil indicated there was an extensive review of the last several years' finances and no discrepancies were found.

## Committee Reports:

-Electric Gate; Carl Steinkraus reported there were no issues. The outside keypad was replaced after 8 years of service. He indicated RDR purchased a KNOX-BOX (for rapid entry for all fire personnel) at the main gate. He requested SNRA share the costs with RDR. Carl made a **motion** to share in those costs for an amount up to \$250. Jim Shockey seconded the motion and passed with no "nays".

-New Members: In Running Deer, James Pliska bought the Weidl property on Running Deer Road; in Ranchos del Lago, Chris and Michelle Gibbs bought lot #18, from the Pruitts; in Tri Counties, Laura Selin bought lot # 84, from Leroy Davis.

-Budget/Maintenance: Russ Johnson reported on the road work that was completed this year and gave an overview (based on the proposed budget) of plans for next year. There was discussion about possible assessment increases in the future to keep up with inflation in road repair materials.

-Fire Committee: Phil indicated there was possible grant money available for fire protection.

-Old Business: none

-New Business: Budget Ballot results showed 99 YES votes and 0 No. The ballot counters included: Toni LoCicero, Bertha Goodwin, Betty Eyraud, Pam Barton, Charlie Hermes, Bert Lindsay and Susie Johnson.
